



2022 PRE-EMPLOYMENT INCOME STATUS

One of the many requirements that the Housing Opportunities Commission of Montgomery County (HOC) must meet to fulfill its obligation for funding made available through federal funded housing programs, is to provide economic opportunities to low-income and very low-income persons. HOC does this in a variety of ways, one of which is through direct employment of low-income and very low-income persons.

In its annual reporting to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), HOC must report on its successes toward meeting this goal. To assist HOC in compiling these required statistics, please indicate below whether you and your family would have been considered a low-income household, **prior** to your employment with HOC.
